Additional & Longer Glue Blocks

3 x stronger connection on the tread/riser joint incorporating additional and longer glue blocks



Pre-Drilled Strings With Optimal Fixing Points

These fixing points highlight where stairs should be fixed and allow simple on-site quality checks during the build process in order to diminish the risk of squeaking stairs and potential customer care issues post occupancy.



Contemporary Balustrades

Based on customer feedback we have streamlined the design of our balusters from 38x38mm to 32x38mm. This change will take place in the coming weeks.



Top Nosing Detail

We are now supplying a new multi-purpose trunk nosing with all stairs. The new nosing is compatible with either 18mm or 22mm thick flooring.



Top Winder Newel Post

Our recently developed string and bracket section is factory fixed to the winder newel post, reducing the number of components necessary to fix on site, and speeding up assembly.



Slip Resistant Stair Tread Protection

Our factory applied peel-clean, slip resistant, tread protection film comes as standard - part of our tested and accredited specification. It keeps installers safe on site whilst preventing damage and expensive remedial costs. We're proud to fly the Staircraft flag by having our logo printed on the film.



Winder Support Bracket

Self-supporting, avoiding the need for full height newel posts, creating more space beneath

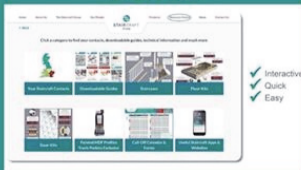
